Stay and Play - Monday 17th November

<u>Friday 12th December</u> at approximately 12pm. All children will be invited for that whole morning, so if your child doesn't usually attend on a Friday, you are invited to bring them along at 9.30am so they can join in the fun.

We will be having a party snack on the same day (taking into account all dietary needs).

The church doors will open at approximately 11.50am but will then be closed at 12pm in order to maintain safety for our children. There will be no restrictions on numbers of people attending this service so we look forward to seeing our families coming to watch.

As we have some very young children and some children who may find it challenging to be on the stage, we want the church to be a safe space, so all doors will be closed and we will be letting those children who need to have a little walk around, do so whilst we do our best to keep as many children on the stage as possible!

We won't know until the day of the nativity who is going to be wearing which costume as the children will be deciding that for themselves on the day. Equally, if they don't wish to wear a costume, that is fine too.

I think you'll agree it should be a very heartwarming performance and one which we can't wait to share with you.
